DO YOU PRAY BELIEVING?

How are you doing talking to God lately? At Thanksgiving time we spend more time thinking about our blessings and for what we have to be thankful don't we? But, I wonder, do we really believe that God actually hears your prayer. I mean, we go through the motions, bow our heads, say the right words, but do we really think anyone hears us other than those around us?

James gives us some interesting insight into prayer in James 1:5-8 where he writes: "If you need wisdom, ask our generous God, and He will give it to you. He will not rebuke you for asking. But when you ask Him, be sure that your faith is in God alone. Do not waver, for a person with divided loyalty is as unsettled as a wave of the sea that is blown and tossed by the wind. Such people should not expect to receive anything from the Lord. Their loyalty is divided between God and the world, and they are unstable in everything they do." (NLT)

They say that is some things "a little child shall lead them." When our oldest son Kirk was only about 5 years old and was kneeling beside his bed one night saying his prayers (from the heart). He prayed, "And God, thank you for my grandma, because she gives me everything I want."
